HISTORY

In 1940, the Sears department store adopted the Silvertone brand name for all of their musical instruments. 1941 marked the first year you could get an electric six-string in the Sears catalog. The selections were limited, but the funky, eclectic styling and easy affordability made them hugely popular with musicians. The electric guitar went solid in the 1950's, and Silvertone was right there in the beginning. Just about every musical icon of the 60's played their first notes on Silvertone guitars. Jimi Hendrix named his 1956 Silvertone "Betty Jean", after his girlfriend. Bob Dylan rocked a Silvertone 1319 in 1958 and can be heard on Dylan's 2006 release, "Modern Times". Silvertone reissue guitars have all the vibe and tone of the original vintage models, but with upgraded features – Better bridges, machine heads and neck joints – that make them true professional instruments for players recording and touring today.

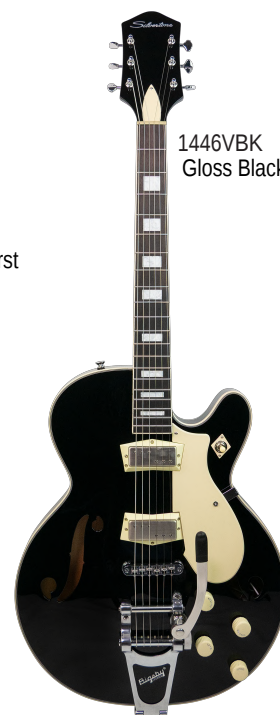

Originally sold through the Sears catalog from 1961 to 1967, the 1446 holds a special place among recording artists and collectors. This meticulously recreated model honors every detail of the original while integrating modern performance features to meet the demands of contemporary stages and studios.

One of the most clever and well-known concepts in the early '60s guitar boom was the Silvertone Amp-in-case line. For well under \$100, you could get a guitar that came in a case featuring a 5-watt (later, 6-watt) tube amp built right in. Just open the case halfway, stand it up, switch it on, and wail. The original guitar in the 1962 kit (1448) was a single pickup, short-neck model. A year later, the 2-pickup 1449 was introduced and the Amp-in-case really took off. The 1449 is the most rare of the breed, being replaced by the almost identical redburst 1457 in 1964.

Silvertone 1303 MKII

The newly redesigned Silvertone 1303's in 'Key West Coral' and 'Copper Metallic' add several new features that enhance playability and versatility. A 'Spoke Wheel' truss rod adjustment has replaced the traditional hex wrench style making adjustments to the neck a snap. The addition of Contemporary 'Hemispherical fret ends' provide an exceptionally comfortable playing surface. Our new Alnico 5 Silvertone Lipstick pickups are designed to offer all the clean tones and transparent bell like treble of the original pickups, with a bit more output to comfortably drive your pedals, tube amp, digital amp modeling amp. We've upgraded the electronics with a robust 3 way 'lever' switch and full-size potentiometers that feel smooth and solid.

The 1303 gets its punch and sustain from the compact, lightweight solid mahogany 57' 'Peanut' body shape and string through body bridge which further enhances the resonance and sustain.

1444 Bass

Offered by Sears back in 1959. It featured a "U" style body with a rounded neck cutaway and aluminum cavity cover. This model 1444 held down the bottom end for Silvertone for 7 strong years, ending production in 1966. The new Silvertone 1444 reissue bass is a modified version of the original Silvertone 1444. It has been redesigned for the modern bassist and can easily produce vintage and modern tones. The Reissue 1444 features a 24 fret 30" short scale rock maple neck with rosewood fingerboard and a solid mahogany body. We modified the bass by adding a bridge position lipstick pickup for added versatility, and a fully adjustable bridge. The electronics are two Silvertone lipstick pickups with Volume, Volume, and Tone controls. Unlike the original 1444, the new reissue also features a fully adjustable dual expanding truss rod.

Hailing back to the year 1961, the Silvertone 604 was a guitar for an entire generation. We liked the 604 so much that we 'upped the ante' so to speak, and took the 604 from a student level guitar to a serious player's instrument.

We changed the old 'hard wood' body to a solid Engelmann Spruce top with Mahogany back and sides. The small Parlor size body makes it the perfect travel guitar, and yes, there is a version (the 604E) with onboard electronic s.

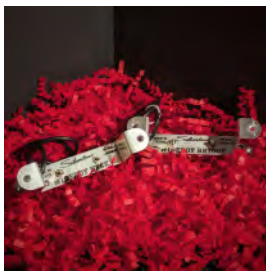
Custom USA 'Wideboy' pickups

Think of it as sounding somewhere between a 60's strat® pickup and a P90.

Hand made in Houston, Texas, this pickup features an Alnico 5 bar magnet with plain enamel 44AWG pure copper wire.

Custom Mini Humbucking pickups

To recreate these iconic pickups, Silvertone enlisted the services of legendary designer Trev Wilkinson. His Wilkinson "R series" pickups use only "vintage correct" materials and parts, assembled with precision and attention to detail that adheres to the historical construction methods used by the pioneers of the original classics. Both the covers and backing plates use unique tooling (rather than just modifying an existing mini humbucker) and the Alnico V bar magnets and winding wire are period correct, and wound to a Lower K Ohms resistance than common mini humbuckers, thereby imparting a unique tonal character to these pickups. The bridge pickup has been slightly overwound by 5% to better match the neck pickups output.

These pickups will install perfectly into any modern mini humbucking size pickup ring.

Silvertone 'TWIN TREM'

The Silvertone 'Twin Trem' features two completely independent tremolo circuits. The left side is a recreation of the original Silvertone optical tremolo, the right side is a modern interpretation of an early 1960's style harmonic tremolo. The two circuits can be used together as a single pedal to create unique otherworldly sound FX. They can also be used like two separate pedals. Each circuit has its own independent input and output jacks. For instance, placing the harmonic tremolo in front of your delay and reverb, and the optical tremolo after the reverb as it was in the original 1484 Twin Twelve.

The two tremolos' can also be run separately in a stereo setup combining the two independent settings in midair!

The Silvertone Twin Trem will transport you to a new dimension of sound.

SP1484TREM**Silvertone 'TWIN TWELVE'**

In 1963, history was made with the release of the Silvertone Twin Twelve Amplifier. Originally listed in the Sears catalog as the 1484, the Twin Twelve was offered from 1963 to 1967 and became the most coveted of all the Silvertone amplifiers. The unique sound of this amplifier proudly powers the tones of many of today's best rock icons such as Jack White, Dave Grohl, Beck, Billie Joe Armstrong (Green Day), Dan Auerbach (The Black Keys) and many more. An exact recreation of the legendary Twin Twelve amplifier, the SP1484 Twin Twelve Pedal can be used as a studio grade preamp, booster, EQ or overdrive depending on how the controls are set. Bring back the classic Silvertone clean and overdriven tones and own the tone of legends.
