

- Double the Bass Part
- Create Melodic Original Parts







Assembly and Maintenance

Parts of the pBone Slide/Slide Lock Body

<u>Left Hand</u> Hand shaped in L Body hole facing down

<u>Right Hand</u> Hand in Mamma mia Slide hole facing up

Cleaning and Maintenance Tips and Tricks

- Cleaning
 - Mouthpiece cleaner
 - Spray (mi-T mist)
 - Dishwasher
 - Trombone Slide cleaner
 - Warm water rinsing!!!!! THIS IS IMPORTANT
 - Trombone slide snake
 - Take them in the bath
 - Multiple User techniques to have efficient/clean playing
 - Storing the mouthpieces
 - Storing the instruments





Cause you know it's all about that BUZZZZZZZZ

- Creating your embouchure
 - Flat chin
 - Corners tucked
 - Air and BUZZ
 - Warmup mouthpiece suggestions
 - Buzzing sirens
 - Long tones
 - Rhythms
- pBone (trombone) is in Bass Clef generally

Changing notation to numbers or using treble clef instead (see handout)



Means your embouchure is more lose the then standard buzz

Means your embouchure is in it's most natural position

• Means your embouchure is tighter than the standard buzz




How to teach pBone parts


- a. Begin to play a part to a song





Articulation/Improvisation Tips

- Taaaaaa for articulation of multiple notes, or to start the sound.
- Consistent air with buzz/gliss
- Part writing!

Major Scales (5 note patterns) Pentatonic




